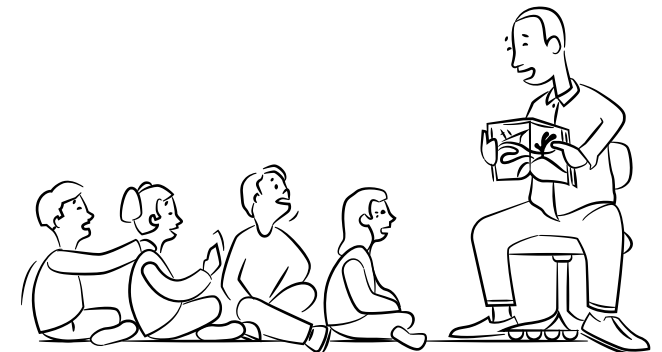

face the challenges of our world, discover their purpose and drive positive change.

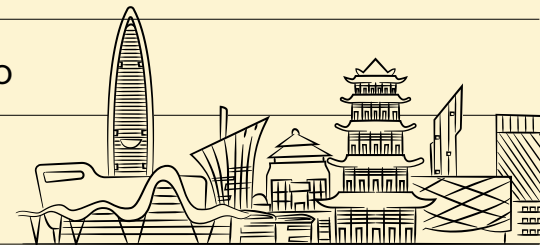

Small beginnings

The very first international school in Qingdao and Shandong province—International School of Qingdao—opens its doors on September 23, 1996, welcoming our initial cohort of eight foreign students.

Our school continues to evolve and moves to the Licang district. With our new location, we bring our Early Childhood Center (ECC) to the same campus.

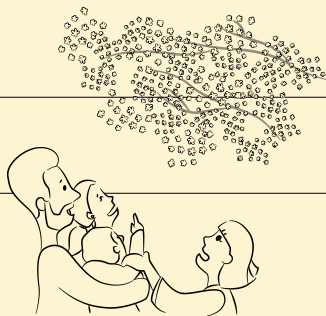
2021

Our Early Childhood Center

In our Early Childhood Center (ECC), every day is a joyful exploration where each learner is valued and nurtured. Under the guidance of dedicated teachers, students embark on a journey of discovery, learning to navigate the world with wisdom, empathy and a spirit of collaboration.



Purposeful play

Purposeful play is a hallmark of our program. Research shows it is one of the most important factors in young students' social-emotional, physical and cognitive development. With the teacher modeling, our littlest learners

explore mathematical wonders, literacy and science through hands-on exploration with their friends. Guided playtime nurtures their curiosity, encouraging them to voice their thoughts confidently and tackle challenges head-on, be it amidst the pages of an engrossing story, the playground or on stage.

Fundamentals

Early childhood is a critical age to begin laying a foundation in fundamental life skills such as developing values and learning integrity, showing good moral character, thinking carefully, communicating clearly, working well with others and taking care of the world around us. The educational experience provided at International School of Qingdao is balanced and varied as the child's world of awareness is extended from the home to the classroom.

Development

The Early Childhood program provides emerging learning experiences in language development, number concepts, creative skills and social and physical development. Students receive

Our Elementary School

Our Elementary program is designed with the knowledge that children in Grades 1–5 learn best through hands-on experience and creativity. Our learners are accepted for who they are and encouraged to blossom at their own rate. Through collaborative projects, use of technology and increased independent learning, students become skilled communicators. They develop into critical thinkers through English language arts, mathematics, science, social studies and Chinese. With a desire to develop well-rounded students, our learners also pursue their interests in art, music, library and physical education every week.

Leadership

At the heart of our learner's education is development of strong character and leadership skills. Through our LifePlus 9 Qualities, learners cultivate emotional intelligence, conflict resolution skills and the ability to forge healthy relationships. These qualities prepare them to learn, love and lead in a global community.

Teacher-student relationships

Research shows teacher-student relationships have the most significant impact on student learning. Our teachers are committed to understanding each



student's strengths and learning and strive to see every student thrive as they become innovative thinkers, skilled communicators and courageous leaders. Our well-being program stands as a pillar of support for both teachers and students, encouraging our learners to grow into active, purposeful individuals.

Well-rounded education

Student well-being at our school extends beyond the classroom,

incorporating enriching experiences and joyful learning. Our after-school offerings provide learners with an array of opportunities to explore different interests and develop new skills, from cooking to martial arts and more. Grades 6–8

Our Middle School

The Middle School program is designed with the awareness that children in Grades 6–8 are establishing their own worldviews and must have the time and tools for imaginative freedom and discovery. It also provides a holistic program that balances the development of concepts, skills and character.

Teachers give each student the chance to question ideas, explore themes and collaborate with others to foster their problem-solving and critical thinking skills. Our approach focuses on the growth of the developing child; addressing social, physical, emotional and cultural needs in addition to academic welfare.

Our comprehensive curriculum emphasizes language arts and math while our specialized enrichment programs in music, art, physical education, language and technology provide students with a varied and rich educational experience.

Leadership development

Unique to LifePlus schools, students take Character Development classes to learn and explore worldview, identity and leadership which, in turn, cultivate lifelong skills and the ability to learn, love and lead. Classes and activities

Well-rounded education

Learners grow holistically through a rich diversity of artistic and cultural experiences.

Visual arts and performing arts enrich student life, teaching teamwork, grit and the thrill of high performance. On-campus Drama events and Fine Art Galas showcase their talents.

Our students connect deeply with China through excursions and service. Excursions range from local explorations like LaoShan to acts of community service. Middle school trips include multi-day Spring Trips around Qingdao, Shandong Province or Beijing as well as sports tournaments around the country.



Grades 9–12

Our High School

Our high school students have a variety of courses to choose from, ranging by subject, which allows students to personalize their learning experiences and deepen their knowledge. Each learner will have a varied learning story that reflects a world-class servant leader; each individual will graduate with their unique aptitudes and interests.

Leaders in the making

Our learners lead and participate in service projects in the school and community. This prepares the way for a leadership style in every student that prioritizes the welfare of others. These experiences are integrated into our curriculum and happen throughout



the academic year, enabling our students to develop key life skills.

Advanced Placement® (AP)

Our AP program courses offer university-level courses and exams to our students who desire to deepen their knowledge of specific subjects to explore future university majors and careers. AP is recognized by more than 3,600 universities worldwide and 85% of selective institutions report AP experience favorably impacts admission decisions.

University preparation

Our high school students explore universities and careers, research university choices, and walk through



university application processes together with our University Guidance Counselor. International School of Qingdao also provides PSAT® (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test), SAT® (Scholastic Aptitude Test) and ACT® (American College Testing) college entrance exams.

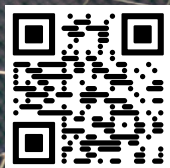


our students to excel in their additional language of English. Our English Language Support (ELS) department stands as a pillar of strength, offering personalized classes and support to ensure their academic success.
