When making payments to our US Bank Account, please contact our Finance Office to confirm the exchange rate (RMB to USD). The exchange rate will be the middle between the buying and the selling rate as established by the Bank of China on the last business day of the prior month.

Registration, re-enrollment, and transportation fees can be paid via bank transfer or WeChat. *Transportation Fees should be paid for the entire year, regardless of tuition payment plans.*

Lunch fee

Lunch deposit can be paid through PowerSchool. Unused lunch fees are refundable.

Late enrollment

Late enrollment Annual Tuition Payment is prorated for new students according to enrollment Quarter. For any other payment plan, please contact the Finance Office to make arrangements.

Finance policies

To reserve your child's seat, the re-enrollment or registration fee (new students) should be paid by the due date listed in the School Fees or in our new student billing notice.

Payments more than *five school days past the due date* are subject to a 50 RMB late fee per school day; students may be excluded from classes until payment is made if payment is more than ten business days past the due date. Report cards and transcripts will be available after excess funds or delinquent accounts are cleared.

Please note

- Assessment fee, Re-enrollment fee, and registration fee (new students) are non-refundable.
- If a student will withdraw early, please notify the Admissions Office at admissions@isqchina.com. Tuition and transportation fees are refunded for remaining full-quarters not attended; the student's remaining lunch account will be refunded.
- No portion of tuition shall be refunded for a student dismissed by expulsion or for disciplinary reasons.
- Grade 12 students who graduate in December will be required to pay 60% of the school annual tuition.
- International School of Qingdao can only issue fapiao (receipts) for registration, re-enrollment, and tuition. Upon request, a transportation fapiao can be issued directly by the bus company.
- This document acts as an invoice; family specific invoices can be provided upon request.
- Parents are responsible to ensure payments are made and our Finance Office is properly notified, including when third parties cover all or part of tuition and fees.
- All school fees are stated in RMB currency.

If the school is unable to provide part or all of the school curriculum due to force majeure such as natural disasters, government actions, social anomalies, etc, the school will not bear financial responsibility. As far as possible, the school will adopt alternative courses (such as online courses or other forms of courses) to achieve the curriculum objectives of normal teaching.
